3.2. Women, family and youth

It is wise and prudent to use for social and economic development all the human factors at the society's disposal - which means also women. We will try to achieve the level where women have equal rights on the job market, in the family and in politics not only legally but also factually, and that they have the right of free determination on their own lives.

We see the alarming drop of the birth rate and the increase in child and youth criminality as an exceptionally important warning. We do not think that feeding and bringing up children is solely a private matter of the parents, but on the contrary we recognize the co-responsibility of the State for healthy population development. The State must create and increase the opportunities for the quality use of the free time of children and young people.

The ever-increasing number of cases of domestic violence leads us to the necessary legislative amendments of criminal law in harmony with European standards. At the same time this problem must be exposed as a problem of the whole society, not only of the "private sector".

One of the most serious problems of young married couples and families with small children is the current housing crisis. We will devote constant attention to the support of public services for families with small children (nurseries, kindergartens, school canteens, extra-school education institutions) and we will create conditions for the educational function of the standard family with children. This will allow the woman to harmonize her function as mother with her economic activities.
