Election procedure for IALHI Secretary

In November 2012, IALHI's Secretary Erik-Jan Zürcher resigned as director of the International Institute of Social History (Amsterdam). This means that a new Secretary has to be elected at the September 2013 conference.

The procedure (following IALHI's statutes and the schedule used in 2010):

- All IALHI members can be a candidate for Secretary. If you would like to run as candidate, please notify me by email at mvh@iisg.nl or by mail at PO Box 2169, 1000 CD Amsterdam, Netherlands.
The deadline for this is 20 June.
- The names of the candidates received on 20 June will be added to the ballot, which will be sent out to IALHI members in the week of 24 June.
- Votes have to be sent back in a closed envelope by 10 September.
- At the Budapest conference, 26 September, all votes received by 10 September will be opened and counted. According to our statutes, "Election of officers [...] shall require a simple majority."
- After counting the votes, the new secretary will be announced.
