A special Gold Medal will be awarded to any competitor beating British Amateur Record and a Bronze Medal to any competitor (other than winners of a First, Second or Third Medal) attaining the appointed Standard in any of the events, either in trial or final heats. No competitor can win more than one standard medal in the same event in any one year.

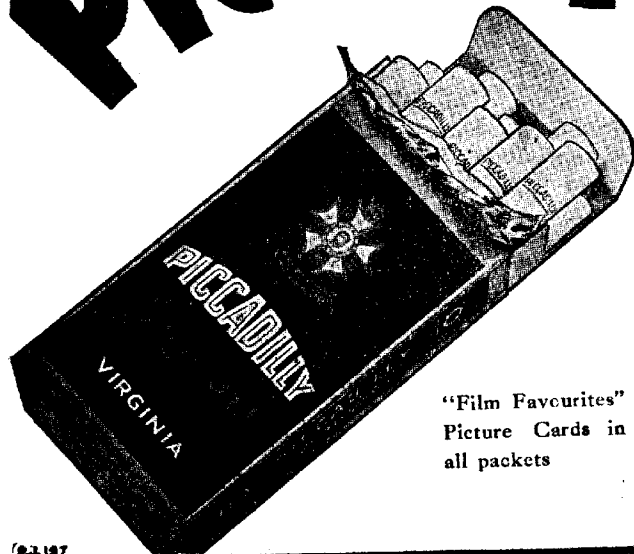

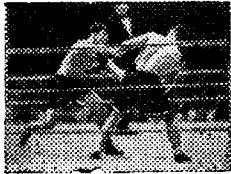

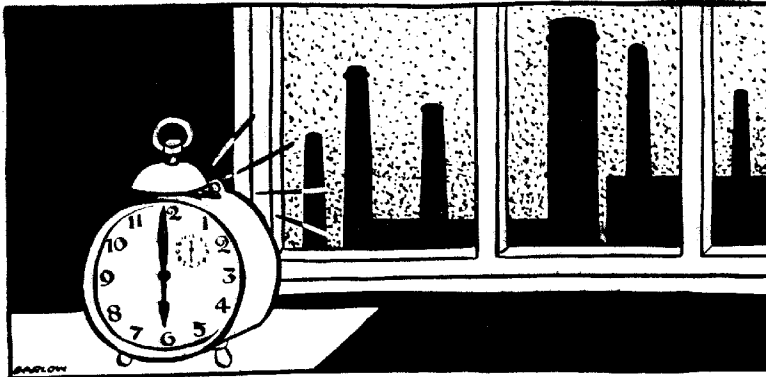
